课程简介 Course Description:

政治经济学是一个基础学科，也是一个跨学科领域。它连接政治学、社会学和经济学，主要研究国家、社会与经济互动的历史、理论、相关专题以及研究方法。本课焦点于政治经济学主要理论范式及其分析方法，介绍以国家、个体、社会、制度和理念等为中心的诸理论视角，并研讨以下主要问题：国家、社会与经济是怎样在国际和国内两个层面互动的？政府应该介入多少经济事务？经济因素是怎样影响国家间的关系和国内政治的？

By introducing the main approaches to political economy, this seminar provides an overview of the field of political economy to students who have no previous background knowledge. The main aim is to help students understand the interaction between political, social and economic systems, forces and actors, and in particular, such interaction at and between international and domestic levels. The main approaches to political economy under review include state, individual, society, institution and idea centered theories and methods of analysis.

Students are expected to do the required readings before class, participate actively in class discussion and do homework.

导读:

本周阅读的核心目的是通过介绍比较政治经济学 (comparative political economy) 和国际政治经济学 (international political economy) 这两个领域了解政治经济学这个学科, 并在此基础上开始理解与其相关的争论。请首先阅读两章教材草稿, 即**基本阅读**, 在阅读过程中试着回答以下问题: 什么是“政治经济学”? 从全章的讨论以及你自己以往的学习经验来看, 还有多少对政治经济学的不同理

解？为什么马克思主义政治经济学只是政治经济学的一部分而不是全部？经济学与政治经济学的区别与联系在哪里？从“国家管理经济”到“国家、社会与经济的关系”是否有顺畅的逻辑？如何理解国家？（根据你的经验，为什么中国学者总是试图将国家理解成主权国家？如何理解与“社会”相对的国家？）如何从政治经济学的基本定义推出“国际政治经济学”和“比较政治经济学”？国际政治经济学与比较政治经济学的区别有哪些？两者有何相似的起源？根据你的经验思考：为什么比较政治经济学不如国际政治经济学更流行、更规范化？

基本阅读过后是一个**经典范例**。请通过阅读体会什么是政治经济学研究？它的特点都有什么？在试图发掘书章中的因果链条时请回答：案例比较如何在挖掘不同因果时起到了关键的作用？这篇书章相对比较易读，但希望你能够尽量体会因果链条后面的理论意义。解释拉美难以发展的理论是什么？这个理论在东亚发生了什么变化？这个变化是特殊的还是具有普遍性的？如何通过这个比较研究来思考发展问题？
